### Trumpet Fiction: Ronald Fink, Danielle Winston, and C.B. Bernard

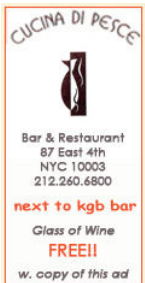
